

**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF
SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ESTABLISHING FEES FOR VARIOUS SERVICES BY THE
SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

On March 24, 2026, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed ordinance to establish fees to be collected by the Sheriff-Coroner's Office, including an overall net fee revenue increase of \$24,895. Areas of change include a projected revenue increase in the Investigations Bureau, a revenue decrease in the Central Information Bureau, a revenue decrease in the Coroner Bureau, a revenue increase in the Patrol Bureau, and a revenue increase in the Telecommunications Bureau. The proposed ordinance was adopted during regular meeting on April 14, 2026. These proposed fee changes would take effect on July 1, 2026, and are necessary to recover the reasonable cost to provide these services.
