The Board of Supervisors voted 4-0-1 to certify the Environmental Impact Report and adopt statements of overriding consideration, adding in a reference to Supplement 4 to the Final EIR. The Board voted 3-1-1 to adopt the Specific Plan, General Plan Amendments, and Zoning Ordinance as recommended by the Planning Commission with the following changes to be incorporated by staff: reduce the expected total units from 1,000 to 750; require compliance with the County's Affordable Housing Program; modify policies to be considered for a development agreement; amend standards for housing for those with developmental disabilities; allow the new road to Highway 12 only for emergency access and egress; maintain the original core campus boundaries but eliminate development on the northern edge of campus, rezone to buffer open space, and designate community separator with the scenic resources combining zone; and make other minor amendments to development standards, fencing, and paving policies.

This Regular Calendar Item was Approved as amended by Resolutions 22-0555, 22-0556 and Ordinance 6400.
