Board Action: Moved by Supervisor Gore, Seconded by Supervisor Hermosillo; Approved as amended by Resolutions 25-0300, 25-0301, and 25-0302.

The Board approved the item as amended, including language in the Resolution to provide ongoing funding to make the Sheriff's Narcotics Unit permanent should the final approved Property Tax Rolls for 2025 include at least \$3.3 million in projected County General Fund revenue above the amount assumed in the budget, and directing staff to return with a needs assessment and long-term staffing strategy for satellite service centers, with all Supervisors voting "yes" with the following exceptions:

- Supervisor Rabbitt voted "yes" to adopt a Concurrent Resolution adopting the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget, including the Position Allocation Listing and final Board direction for all entities governed by the Board of Supervisors/Directors/Commissioners (Tab 12), but abstained under the Levine Act from participating in the vote on the Supplemental Adjustment identified by Adjustment ID Cap-SUP-01 which is found under Tab 8 (entitled FY 2025-26 Supplemental Adjustments), Attachment A, p. 5 of 6, which establishes expenditure appropriations for the improvements to 3850 and 3880 Brickway Boulevard.
- Supervisor Coursey voted "yes" to adopt a Concurrent Resolution adopting the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget, including the Position Allocation Listing and final Board direction for all entities governed by the Board of Supervisors/Directors/Commissioners (Tab 12), except for voting "no" on the Supplemental Adjustment identified by Adjustment ID Cap-SUP-01 which is found under Tab 8 (entitled FY 2025-26 Supplemental Adjustments), Attachment A, p. 5 of 6, which establishes expenditure appropriations for the improvements to 3850 and 3880 Brickway Boulevard.
