SUBJECT: Selection of NEXGEN Asset Management, Inc. for Computerized Maintenance

Management Services

Sonoma County Water Agency (Sonoma Water) has multiple systems for managing and maintaining asset information and has initiated a project to implement asset management practices to integrate the available information to enhance the decision-making process for managing these assets (Project).

The goal of implementing a CMMS is to support managing Sonoma Water's physical above- and below-ground assets to maintain assets at their lowest lifecycle costs, while delivering expected levels of service.

The Project will replace Sonoma Water's existing CMMS system, Maximo. It is anticipated that there will be approximately 30 to 40 total users.

Sonoma Water will be implementing an integrated commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) packaged CMMS solution that will meet Sonoma Water's core requirements with minimal modifications.

On April 13, 2022, Sonoma Water issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to the following eight firms:
