What's Important to Know

- This is an annual effort.
- These are contracts for mostly State and Fed funds allocated to or directly awarded to the Sonoma County Homeless Coalition (Continuum of Care), to be ratified by the Board of Supervisors.
- Some are funds from US HUD to County/DHS for specific CoC Program costs (like Coordinated Entry, HMIS, CoC Lead Agency staffing)
- CoC went through a NOFA process this year with a series of public meetings to rate and review projects
- Projects are all aligned with the 5 Year Strategic Plan on Homelessness

Homelessness Prevention Pilot Project

- Collaboration with the City of Santa Rosa (Lead), City of Petaluma, and All Home
- Designed to support 160 households a year from becoming homeless
- Critical to address inflow

How it Works

- Part of 1-2-4 Strategy. Fund Interim Housing (1), Fund at least two permanent housing solutions for every interim unit (2) and Fund (4) households with prevention services
- All Home (nonprofit) has developed this in multiple counties

Sonoma County Prevention Pilot

Funding

- \$1.3M local + \$1.3M All Home
- = \$2.6M 2 year Pilot Program

- Regional Administrator Coordinate overall system with "Local Hubs"
- BACS Online platform

Sonoma County Prevention Pilot

- March-April 2024: Pilot concept shared with CoC and feedback sought through All Home outreach
- April-May 2024: County of Sonoma, Cities of Santa Rosa and Petaluma match funding confirmed by Board of Supervisors and City Councils
- May-June 2024: Pilot Regional Administrator selected
- July-September 2024: All contracts/subcontracts finalized for Pilot launch
- October 2024: Pilot launch includes county-wide communications and training with CoC members
- October 2024-September 2026: Pilot project period

Recommended Actions

- Authorize Director of Health Services to execute local homeless program contracts for FY 24-25 for a total not to exceed \$8,495,736
- Authorize Director of Health Services to execute a funding agreement in the amount of \$500,000 with the City of Santa Rosa using State Homeless Housing Incentive Program (HHIP) funding to support a regional homelessness prevention pilot project
- Related budget resolution for the above funding for homeless contracts in the amount of \$6,764,798
