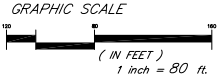

- California Black Oak (Quercus kelloggii)
- Chaparral Clematis (Clematis lasiantha)
- California Dutchman's Pipe or Pipe Vine (Aristolochia californica)
- California Honeysuckle (Lonicera hispidula)
- Western White Clematis (Clematis ligusticifolia)
- California Morning Glory (Calystegia macrostegia)
- Pacific False Bindweed (Calystegia purpurata)
- San Diego Sweetpea (Lathyrus laetiflorus atefeldii)
- Pink Flowered Currant (Ribes sanguineum glutinosum)
