

**SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING NEW FEES AND  
ADJUSTING FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026 FOR SONOMA COUNTY  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY**

Pursuant to Government Code Sections 25124(b), on or after , the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of an ordinance adopting new fees and adjusting fees for Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory, effective July 1, 2026.

Adoption of the proposed fees for Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory would result in an overall net fee revenue increase of \$14,317. All Public Health Laboratory fees are proposed to increase by 3% to keep pace with increased operational costs. In addition, the Frozen Yogurt Panel (which includes both Yeast & Mold Count and Coliform testing for soft serve) is proposed to increase from \$38.50 to \$79, representing a 105% increase.
