**Resolution of The Board of Supervisors of The County Of Sonoma, State of California,
Ratifying the Proclamation of Local Emergency Due to the Kincade Fire, Extreme Fire Danger
Weather and De-Energization in the Sonoma County Operational Area**

Whereas, on October 24, 2019, the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Sonoma Issued a Proclamation of a Local Emergency for the County of Sonoma, State of California related to the Kincade Fire and risk of additional fires in light of the Kincade fire, extreme fire danger weather and concurrent Pacific Gas and Electric ("PG&E") de-energization events underway and anticipated (the "Director's Declaration of Local Emergency"); and

Whereas, pursuant to Sonoma County Code Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-5, where the Director of Emergency Services proclaims a local emergency, the Board of Supervisors must ratify said declaration within seven (7) days after such proclamation; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the circumstances of the Kincade Fire and danger of additional fires as described in the Director's Declaration of Local Emergency do constitute a risk of extreme peril and support and justify the declaration of local emergency set forth therein, the request for the Governor of the State of California to proclaim a Stage of Emergency; and the request to make additional assistance available, including but not limited to California Disaster Act Assistance; and
