Why are you interested in serving on a board or commission?

My entire professional career is related to the design, construction, and maintenance of transportation infrastructure. I was involved directly in both the development and delivery phases of transportation projects for the Sonoma County Transportation and Public Works Department (now called Public Infrastructure) and the Sonoma County Transportation Authority. These projects included both Sonoma County local road network roads and bridges projects and California Highway 101 Corridor (Measure M) projects. I was involved in all aspects of project development and delivery including funding/bonding/budgeting, scheduling, design, acquiring consultants, PAED (Project Approval and Environmental Documentation), public meetings, right-of-way acquisition, resource agency permitting, impacts mitigation, PS&E (Plans, Specifications, and Estimates), bidding, contracts, and construction. Although I am, by no means, an expert in any of the above mentioned phases of project delivery, I have direct working experience in all the phases in my management background. For an engineer, I think I have decent communication skills. I have made numerous reports to the County and SCTA Boards, City Councils, and a variety of public groups. I have worked with numerous public agencies and Caltrans at the upper management level. I think I would be able to represent Sonoma County on the RM3 Independent Oversight Committee in a responsible fashion. I have interest in public projects and the overall public good that government provides. Since RM3 projects are a ready identified, the emphasis will be in the project delivery phase and programming of funds for the project.
