SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING NEW FEES AND ADJUSTING FEES EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2025 FOR SONOMA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY

Pursuant to Government Code Sections 25124(b), on or after August 26, 2025, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors will consider adoption of an ordinance establishing new fees and adjusting fees for Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory, effective October 1, 2025.

Adoption of the proposed fees for Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory would result in an overall net fee revenue increase of \$36,720. The amended fees reflect an approximate 8% increase to most Public Health Laboratory fees to recover rising labor and supply costs, based on a February 2025 third-party fee study. Xpert Xpress SARS-CoV-2/Flu/RSV, Nucleic Acid Amplification Test (NAAT) fee includes a 31% correction due to a prior error.
