Mary Miller is an accomplished science and climate communicator and is emeritus program director for environmental science at the San Francisco Exploratorium, where she developed extensive partnerships with scientists from NOAA, NASA, UC Berkeley, Stanford and other leading research institutions. Mary has a B.A. in biology and marine studies and a master's certificate in science communication from U.C. Santa Cruz. She developed the digital media production track and taught for 10 years at the UC Santa Cruz Science Communication Program. While at the Exploratorium, she led multidisciplinary teams in creating innovative and engaging content about current environmental and scientific research for the museum's award-winning website, exhibits and public programs. She has experience as a livestream producer and program host, science and environment writer, online media producer, interviewer, and curator.

With a background in climate and marine science, Mary collaborates with the ocean observing and conservation communities. She chairs the Executive Committee of the Central and Northern Ocean Observing System's Governing Council and is on the Sanctuary Advisory Council for the Farallones National Marine Sanctuary in Northern California (both volunteer positions). She also partners and collaborates with scientists from these organizations to create engaging content for visualizations, media narratives, and interpretations of ongoing environmental research, including climate change and ocean and atmospheric research. She is the pioneer for the Exploratorium's "Wired Pier" project that instrumented the waterfront museum with environmental sensors to gather and display water quality, weather, air quality and oceanographic data and make that data available to the public through displays, websites and interactive exhibits. I live in a Wildland Urban Interface and a Cal Fire SRA, just north of the City of Sonoma. Consequently, I have been extremely interested and studied wildfire suppression, wildfire protection, and wildfire evacuation for the past six years. As a retired physicist (beginning 10 years ago), I've read and accumulated an extensive bibliography of professional, trade, and news articles on wildfire in rural and urban areas. In addition I've also had discussions with Tom Cova of the Univ. of Utah on fire speeds and evolution in Sonoma County, as enhanced by both the drying out and flooding brought on by Climate Change. My professional work consisted of running, managing, and accounting for up to \$15M programs, which worked to solve technical problems in nuclear arms control. I am thus familiar with the accounting of large expenditure programs, and for the design and tracking of complex projects. Sonoma County faces the problem of balancing powerful housing pressure from the State with the dangers of building in areas of high fire-hazard vegetation. No one here wants a Paradise or a Palisades fire, and I feel well-positioned to work with others to make effective recommendations about limiting the fire danger and hardening firefighting emergency support as needed for Measure H.

Measure H demands the development of a sustainable fire response infrastructure that addresses wildfire protection, as well as paramedic response.
