Recommended Action:

Adopt a resolution honoring veterans of the armed services and recognizing and honoring May 27, 2019, as "Memorial Day" in Sonoma County.

Executive Summary:

There are over 23,000 Veterans in Sonoma County, as well as many families who have lost loved ones in service to our nation. This resolution is an acknowledgement of their sacrifice.

Discussion:

Memorial Day was first observed as Decoration Day on May 30, 1868, as an occasion to decorate the graves of Civil War Soldiers. After World War I, Decoration Day was expanded to honor service members killed in all of our nation's wars. After World War II, Decoration Day became known as Memorial Day; and in 1971, Congress established Memorial Day as a federal holiday to be observed on the last Monday of May. While we observe Memorial Day in 2019, it is important to reflect upon the contributions and sacrifices the men and women of our armed forces have made in upholding the principles of democracy and liberty while in service to our nation.

Over 23,000 Veterans and numerous families who have lost loved ones in service to our nation reside in Sonoma County; it is fitting to honor and commend the citizens of Sonoma County, as well as the men and women that served with military units based in Sonoma County, who were killed in the line of duty. We can never fully repay our debt of gratitude to the heroic men and women who perished as a result of their service.
