This Amendment Number 1 ("Amendment") is by and between the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County"), and Council on Aging Services for Seniors, a California non-profit Corporation designated as a Sub-recipient of federal funds (hereinafter "Contractor").

As provided by Article 13.7, Merger, the parties hereby evidence their intent and desire to amend the Agreement. The parties mutually desire to amend said Agreement to make the following changes:

- 1. Revise Article 2, Payment, to increase the Agreement amount by One Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$122,778) for a new total of One Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$1,666,278).
- 2. Revise Exhibit A: Scopes of Work, as follows:
 - a. Add 3.4-c, replace 4.3, and replace 5.1 and 5.2 in Exhibit A-1, Scope of Work for Adult Day Care.
 - b. Replace 3.1 in Exhibit A-3, Scope of Work for Congregate Meals.
 - c. Replace 5.1 in Exhibit A-4, Scope of Work for Home Delivered Meals.
- Replace the following line item budget tables in Exhibit B: Fiscal Provisions/ Budget: 10.1 Adult Day Care; 10.3 Congregate Meals; and 10.4 Home Delivered Meals.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into that certain Agreement, dated July 1, 2023, for Adult Day Care, Alzheimer's Day Program, Congregate Meals, Home Delivered Meals, Nutrition Education, and related services for seniors; and

WHEREAS, County and Contractor desire to amend the Agreement to provide additional funding for Adult Day Care, Congregate Meals, and Home Delivered Meals services and to update certain scope of work components and units of service;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto are desirous of modifying the Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein and hereto agree as follows:

SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

2. Payment.

For all services and incidental costs required hereunder, Contractor shall be paid on a cost reimbursement basis in accordance with the budget set forth in "Exhibit B: Fiscal Provisions/Budget" (hereinafter "Exhibit B"), attached hereto and incorporated herein by

this reference. Contractor shall be paid an amount not to exceed One Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$1,666,278), without the prior written approval of County. Expenses not expressly authorized by the Agreement shall not be reimbursed.

Unless otherwise noted in this agreement, payments shall be made within the normal course of county business after presentation of an invoice in a form approved by the County for services performed. Payments shall be made only upon the satisfactory completion of the services as determined by the County.
