**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,
Honoring Shea Marcus Tamura for Achieving the Rank of Eagle Scout**

Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America have a long and impressive history of preparing young men to assume responsibility in their communities; and

Whereas, Shea Marcus Tamura has been a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 74 of Petaluma since May 1, 2019, and has worked diligently and completed his ranking of Eagle Scout on April 21, 2026; and

Whereas, Shea has earned 28 merit badges: Art, Bird Study, Camping, Chess, Citizenship in the Community, Citizenship in the Nation, Citizenship in the World, Citizenship in Society, Climbing, Communications, Cooking, Emergency Preparedness, Environmental Science, Family Life, Fingerprinting, First Aid, Game Design, Nature, Personal Fitness, Personal Management, Photography, Rifle Shooting, Small Boat Sailing, Shotgun Shooting, Stamp Collecting, Swimming, Wilderness Survival and Wood Carving; and

Whereas, Shea served in the leadership positions of Quartermaster, Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader, servin as Senior Patrol Leader for 765 days; and

Whereas, Shea has attended 3 summer camps, Camp Wente, 2021 and 2024, Camp Marin Sierra, 2022, Camp Hi Sierra, 2023, and participated in a 50-miler backpacking trip to Lassen Volcanic National Park; and

Whereas, Shea's Eagle Scout Project consisted of anchoring signs for the Casa Grande High School fish hatchery along Petaluma Creek.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors commends Shea Marcus Tamura on joining the outstanding group of Eagle Scouts.
