**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, to
Affirming and Approving Delegation of Authority to Redwood Children’s Center for the
Application and Implementation of Grant Programs**

Whereas, the Human Services Department desires to pursue opportunities for funding through grants to provide essential services at the Redwood Children’s Center; and

Whereas, the Redwood Children’s Center is an accredited Child Advocacy Center that serves as the coordination hub for investigation and intervention services for child victims of sexual and physical abuse; and

Whereas, the Victims of Crime Act grant will fund ongoing therapeutic services for victims and their families; will provide advocacy, supportive and resources for child victims of sexual assault; and will provide continuing professional development for multidisciplinary staff; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors deems it necessary to grant authority to the Director of the Human Services Department, or their designee, to act on behalf of Sonoma County in applying for and accepting grant funds, with approval by County Counsel, to include agreements that require matching funds up to 25% of the award amount;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Human Services Department or their designee, with the approval of County Counsel, to execute for, and on behalf of, the County of Sonoma, a public entity established

under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining state or federal financial assistance for the benefit of the Redwood Children’s Center from the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services, and to include all matters related to the grant application and implementation including extensions, modifications or amendments thereof.

Be It Resolved that this authority will be in effect until this resolution is revoked or modified by a subsequent resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
