**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Authorizing a Budgetary Adjustment to the Revised Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Budget for the County Administrator's Office per the Climate Smart Commodities Grant Amendment Received from the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors has adopted a Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Final Budget for the County of Sonoma County Administrator's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Government Code allows for adjustments to the Final Budget during the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors accepted a Climate Smart Commodities Grant from the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service on August 22, 2023 to assist with the goal of maximizing opportunities for mitigation of climate change and adaptation through improved land use and agricultural practices, and increased carbon sequestration; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Sonoma has received additional funding through an Amendment of the Climate Smart Commodities Grant from the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service;
