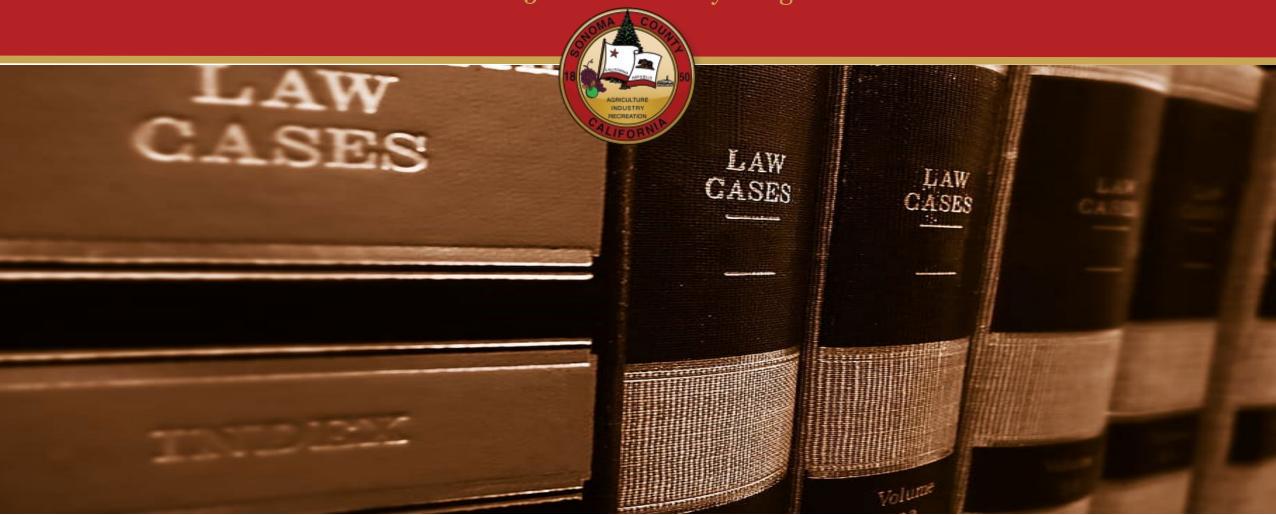

Key Opportunities and Challenges

- Establishing a comprehensive succession planning and crosstraining program to strengthen the department's talent pool and enhance its resilience, in preparation for anticipated workforce attrition due to retirements and unanticipated departures, while ensuring continuity in service delivery.
- Proactively engaging with clients at the outset of projects to identify legal issues and propose solutions before it becomes too late for corrective measures.

 Implement robust succession plan and cross-training program to increase the department's bench strength to prepare for retirements and unanticipated departures and ensure continuity in service delivery.



 Provide legal support and strategic guidance to further the County's Comprehensive Planning Priorities, encompassing the following initiatives: 2030 General Plan Update; Specific Plans for the Springs and the Airport Area; and Cannabis Ordinance and Program Update.

Key Operational Objectives

 Continue to provide legal support and counsel to ensure the full implementation and ongoing refinement of the County's Care Court, and SB43,which modernizes the state's mental health conservatorship laws.



• Continue to provide legal support to County to assist with the construction of the public health lab and morgue and environmental analysis for the new County Center.
