Cannabis Business Tax



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Recommended Actions

- Consider an Ordinance amending Chapter 35, the Cannabis Business Tax Ordinance, establishing new tax rates for cannabis cultivation, cannabis retail (dispensary) and cannabis manufacturing operations, effective July 1, 2024, including administrative and technical corrections; and
- Adopt a Resolution introducing, reading the title of, and waiving further reading of a proposed ordinance amending Chapter 35 of the Sonoma County Code.



2024 Annual Review Findings

- Cultivation volume down
- Indoor cultivation prices have decreased
- Outdoor cultivation prices generally decreased, but not as much due to increased prices for large flower (bud)
- Market price for outdoor cultivation is much lower than for indoor cultivation
 - Average indoor cultivation operation generates gross earnings of \$3M
 - Average mixed-light cultivation operation generates gross earnings of \$1M
 - Average outdoor cultivation operation generates gross earnings of \$277,000



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Program Costs

- Estimated program costs for FY24-25 are \$1.7M increasing to \$1.8M by FY26-27
- EIR and Program
 Update estimated
 costs of \$2.6M over
 four fiscal years
 through FY24-25

- 10 positions in five County depts.:
 - AWM
 - Permit Sonoma
 - CAO
 - Health Services
 - ACTTC
- Costs also include legal and contract services

Options

- No action, annual CPI adjustment will occur on July 1, 2024
- 2. Maintain current tax rates, suspend annual CPI adjustment
- 3. Adjust cannabis business tax rates



Staff Recommendation

Adjust cannabis business tax rates as follows:

- Cannabis cultivation tax rates:
 - \$0.69/sq. ft. for outdoor cultivation
 - \$2.51/sq. ft. for mixed-light cultivation
 - \$7.58/sq. ft. for indoor cultivation
- Cannabis supply chain operation tax rates:
 - 3.0% for retail (dispensary) operations
 - 1.5% for manufacturing operations
