Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Celebrating and Acknowledging the B'nai Israel Jewish Center's 100th Anniversary

Whereas, since 1864, Petaluma has been home to many Jewish families seeking a better life of freedom and opportunities. They came from diverse cultural, educational, political and spiritual backgrounds, but shared a common bond to create a meaningful center of Jewish life; and

Whereas, together, they created Congregation Society B'nai Israel, receiving incorporation in California in 1871; and

Whereas, for many years they relied on private homes and public halls to gather, until 1925 when they pooled their resources to build a permanent home, the Petaluma Jewish Center, which is still thriving today as B'nai Israel Jewish Center; and

Whereas, the Center at 740 Western Avenue still stands today as a proud testament to the dedication and perseverance of the founding families; and

Whereas, one hundred years later, a vibrant Jewish Center, is dedicated to diversity, education, cultural events, music and youth and family programming for its members and for the wider community; and

Whereas, the Congregation Society B'nai Israel of Petaluma is the oldest Jewish community between San Francisco and Portland, Oregon. Its center stands as a community hub, synagogue space and beloved Gan Israel Preschool; and

Whereas, the Center prides itself on being part of the diverse tapestry of cultural resources in Sonoma County, and works to continue the vision of its founders to be a vibrant Jewish Center for its members and for the wider community.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors does hereby celebrate and acknowledge the B'nai Israel Jewish Center the 100th anniversary.
