### SUMMARY


The following diagrams display the state of the current legacy Integrated Justice System (IJS) and the expected state at the end of Phase III of this project.

Currently, legacy IJS is the platform that enables the sharing of data between the justice partners, including the Courts. It also serves as the case management system (CMS) and juvenile detention system for the Probation Department, the jail management system (JMS) for the Sheriff's Office, and the central warrant system (CWS) utilized by multiple justice partners.

During Phase III of this project, the Courts and Public Defender are migrating to new CMS platforms, and the Sheriff's Office will be migrating to a new JMS. These new platforms will integrate with the new IJS Exchange, which follows the Department of Justice (DOJ) recommended standards for sharing justice information. The District Attorney's CMS is currently being integrated with the new IJS Exchange. The Probation CMS and juvenile detention system will remain in the legacy IJS, along with the central warrant system, until new solutions are selected and implemented.




# Current Legacy IJS System




Beginning in the early/mid 2010s, the Courts, Public Defender, and District Attorney transitioned off Legacy IJS to off-the-shelf third-party systems. Sheriff JMS, Warrants, and Probation Case Management System/Juvenile Detention still reside in Legacy IJS.
