Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma And The Board of Directors Of The Sonoma County Water Agency, State Of California, Authorizing Adjustments For Fees Supporting Seasonal Day Use Parking, Residence Maintenance Fees, Camp Fees, Enhanced Recreational Programs And Inflatable Water Park Fees; And Approval of New Fees For Classroom Based Field Trips and Cabana Rentals.

Whereas, the Sonoma County Water Agency owns Spring Lake Park and the County of Sonoma operates and maintains Spring Lake Park; and

Whereas, fees are charged to recover the reasonable cost of maintaining Spring Lake Park for public use and recover the reasonable cost of providing government services which will generate revenue for the County of Sonoma and offset expenses incurred in the operation and maintenance of this facility; and

Whereas, adjustments to various fees supporting seasonal day use parking, residence maintenance fees, school field trips, educational programs, classroom pre-visits, camp fees, enhanced recreational programs and inflatable water park fees will increase revenue so the General Funds does not have to be used to pay for these services provided to the fee payors;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that to recover the reasonable cost of providing certain parks services, it is necessary to increase certain fees and establish certain new fees as set forth below:
