Sonoma County Animal Services (SCAS) plays a crucial role in safeguarding the welfare of animals within our region.





### **Operational Challenges**

- Lack of shelter capacity: limiting animal well-being and posing operational difficulties
- Inadequate infrastructure: outdated kennel areas, lack of shelter in play yards, inefficient storage spaces
- Limited staffing levels: growing demand for community and in-shelter support
- Increasing volume of public complaints: response times, and communication

### **Facility Improvements**

#### **Space Needs**

**Expand Office Space & Lobby:** Expansion of office space and lobby area to address privacy concerns, operational inefficiencies, and safety risks

**Upgrade Kennel Area:** Improved ventilation and climate control solutions to promote better airflow and reduce temperature extremes

**Install a Play Yard Shelter:** Installation of permanent shelter solutions to ensure the safety of animals and volunteers

**Improve Storage Area:** Upgrade storage facilities to mitigate risk such as leaks and excessive heat damage

#### Initial Facility Investment Estimate

Design \$300,000 (included in Capital Projects 24/25 Recommended Budget) + \$4M Improvements Construction.
