## Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Certifying the Applicable National Objective of Four Disaster Recovery Projects under the CBDG 17DR Infrastructure Program

Whereas, on May 11, 2021, this Board authorized funding under the State of California's Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program for 2017 disasters; and

Whereas, the application was approved and funding was awarded for the following "Urgent Need" projects: DR-INF 1 Streetlight Damage, DR-INF 2 County-wide Guardrail Replacement, DR-INF 3 STS Airport Generator, and DR-INF 4 Maintenance Yard Generator; and

Whereas, all four projects have been completed in accordance with the approved scope of work and program requirements and this Board authorized closeout on February 25, 2025; and

**Whereas,** Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations require a resolution certifying the applicable national objective as part of the closeout documentation.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby:

(1) Certifies, for the purpose of HUD grant closeout, that the above-listed projects were carried out under the "Urgent Need" national objective of the CDBG-DR Program. Resolution #25-Date: Page 2

- (2) Finds that each project was designed to address conditions posing a serious and immediate threat to public health and welfare, resulting from the 2017 disasters; that such conditions were of recent origin; and that other funding sources were not available at the time of application.
- (3) Directs the Department of Public Infrastructure to submit this resolution as part of the grant closeout process to the California Department of Housing and Community Development.
