**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
ADOPTING THE SONOMA COUNTY VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN**

Whereas, Vision Zero is a strategy to eliminate traffic fatalities and severe injuries among all road users to ensure safe, healthy, and equitable mobility for all; and

Whereas, in October 2019, the Sonoma County Transportation Authority (SCTA) launched a Vision Zero planning process in partnership with the Sonoma County Department of Health Services (DHS); and

Whereas, the SCTA and DHS convened a Vision Zero Advisory Committee comprised of members from all ten jurisdictions within Sonoma County, including Sonoma County, as well as non-profit organizations, community members, and public health and safety agencies; and

Whereas, after months of data-gathering, agency participation, community engagement and plan development, the Vision Zero Advisory Committee has produced the Sonoma County Vision Zero Action Plan; and

Whereas, the Sonoma County Vision Zero Action Plan contains specific actions and measures to achieve a target goal of zero traffic deaths and severe injuries on roadways in Sonoma County by 2030; and

Whereas, Vision Zero implementers will involve a wide range of stakeholders, including: local agency transportation departments, law enforcement agencies, community

organizations, and various health and education stakeholders; and

Whereas, the adoption of the Vision Zero Action Plan will increase the County's eligibility and competitiveness for future Federal and State grant opportunities; and

Whereas, the implementation measures in the Vision Zero Action Plan will build on the County's current work toward a safer transportation system and supports the County's numerous General Plan goals including reducing traffic accidents and hazards, providing for safe bicycle, pedestrian and transit facilities, and reducing greenhouse gases; and

Whereas, other ongoing initiatives in the County, including Safe Routes to School programs and the Local Road Safety Plan are supportive of the Vision Zero goal; and

Whereas, the SCTA Board of Directors adopted the Vision Zero Action Plan at their March 14, 2022, meeting; and

Whereas, participating agencies are also asked to consider adopting the Vision Zero Action Plan.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Sonoma County Vision Zero Action Plan.
