



Sonoma County Sheriff's Office 2025 US Immigration and Customs Enforcement Data

The Sonoma County Sheriff's Office 2025 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Programs participation is governed Government Code 7283.1 (d). Specifically:

- Government Code 7283.1 (d), part of Government Code Chapter 17.2 Standards for Participation in United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Programs, requires that the Board of Supervisors hold a public forum to provide information to the public about ICE's access to individuals and to receive and consider public comment.
- The Code also specifies that the Sheriff may provide related data to the Board as part of this forum.

Regarding participation and cooperation with ICE the Sheriff's Office: protects public safety, helps undocumented victims obtain U-Visas, provides inmate release dates to the public, and provides incarcerated persons release dates per Senate Bill 54. The Sonoma County Sheriff's Office does not: enforce Federal immigration law, deport anyone, ask for immigration status, have authority over ICE, or conduct immigration sweeps.

In compliance with GC 7283.1(d), the Sheriff's Office has compiled the below ICE participation data for calendar year 2025.

Notification Requests Received from ICE for Impending Release	601
Requests received from ICE for notification information. Most of such requests are sent by fax to the Main Adult Detention Facility.	
Notifications Returned to ICE Regarding Impending Release	69
Responses returned to ICE regarding notification requests. Sheriff staff members document all communication for tracking purposes. As court cases span time on an individual basis, the originating request may come from a previous year – the return occurred during 2024.

<p>Notifications Rescinded by ICE</p> <p>Request by ICE to cancel notification.</p>	1
<p>ICE United States District Court Warrants Received</p> <p>ICE United States District Court Warrants received by Sheriff's Detention staff. These warrants are faxed to the Main Adult Detention Facility.</p>	2
<p>Transfers/Releases to ICE</p> <p>Incarcerated persons who are transferred to ICE if held on a Federal Warrant signed by a US Magistrate.</p>	1
<p>Arrests by ICE in Detention Facility</p> <p>ICE arrests in the Sheriff's Detention Facilities.</p>	20
<p>ICE Requests to Interview</p> <p>ICE may request to interview an incarcerated person. ICE submits these requests by phone, e-mail, or fax. Sheriff's staff documents the results for tracking purposes.</p>	0
<p>Interviews Conducted</p> <p>The number of times ICE conducts an interview with the incarcerated persons authorization.</p>	0
<p>Interviews Declined</p> <p>Per SB54 incarcerated persons are notified that they have the right to decline an interview. Sheriff's staff documents the results for tracking purposes.</p>	0
<p>ICE Requests for Information</p> <p>ICE makes incarcerated person information inquiries; typically, these are notification requests for individuals that are already released from custody – because this form is requesting release information, and the individuals are no longer in custody this request is not responded to. Additionally, ICE may call or send an email. Sheriff staff documents all inquiries for tracking purposes.</p>	152

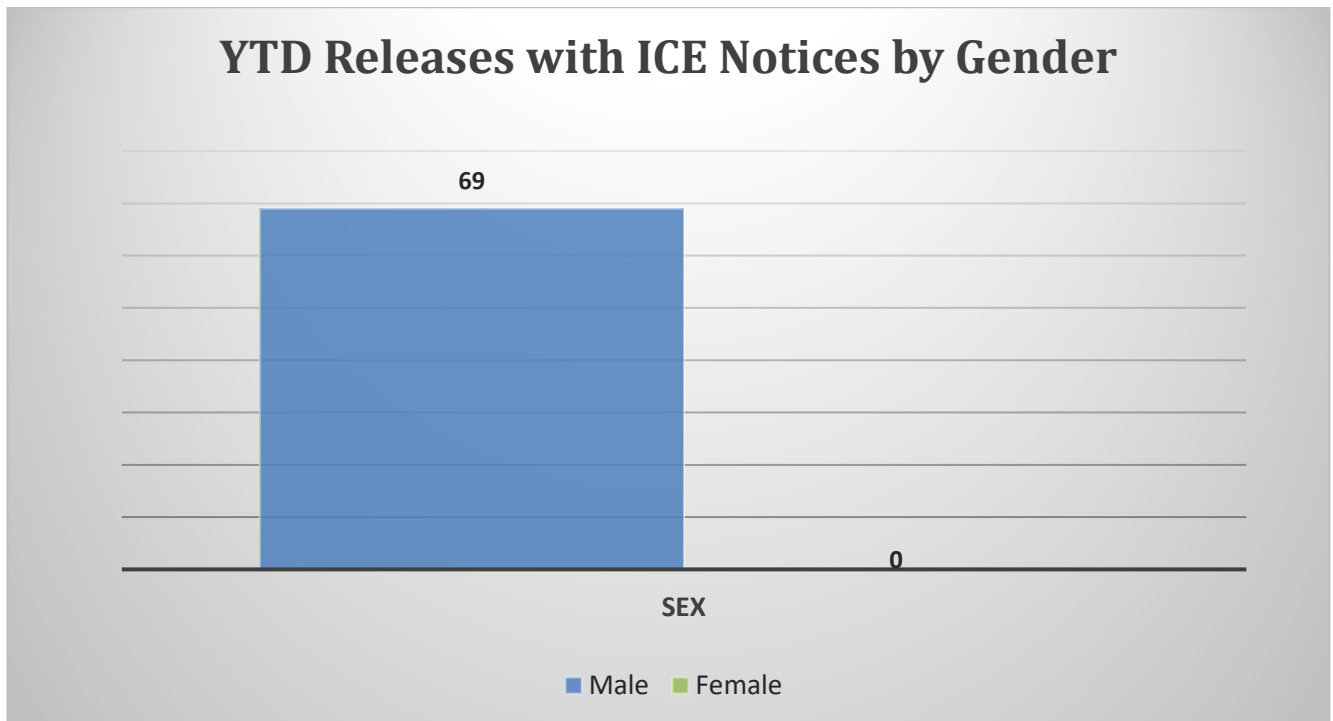
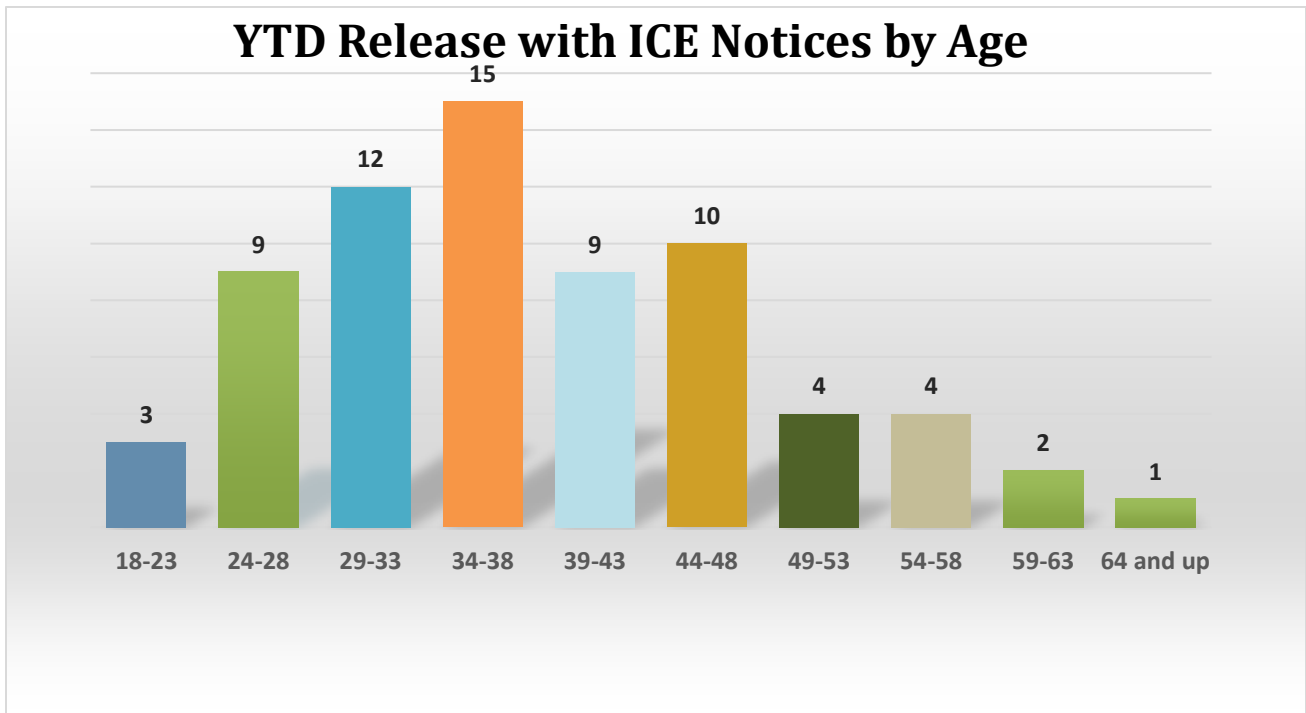
Incarcerated Person Reviews Conducted	1

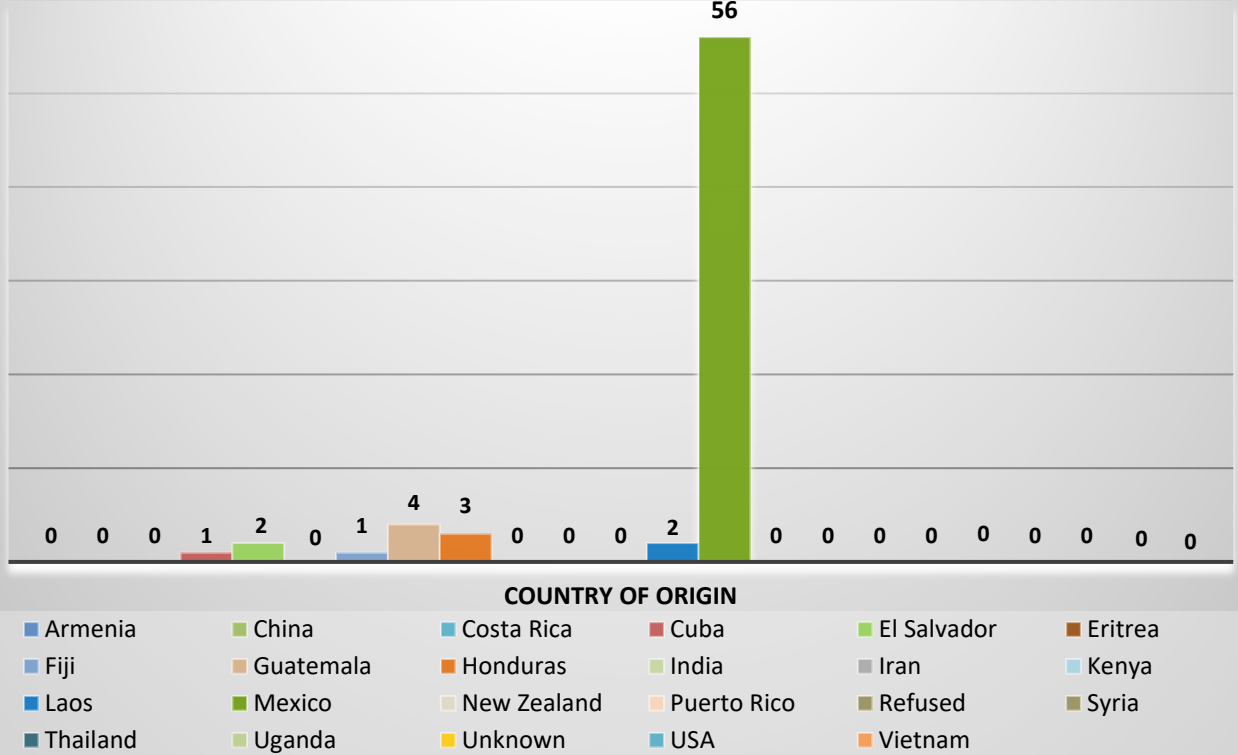

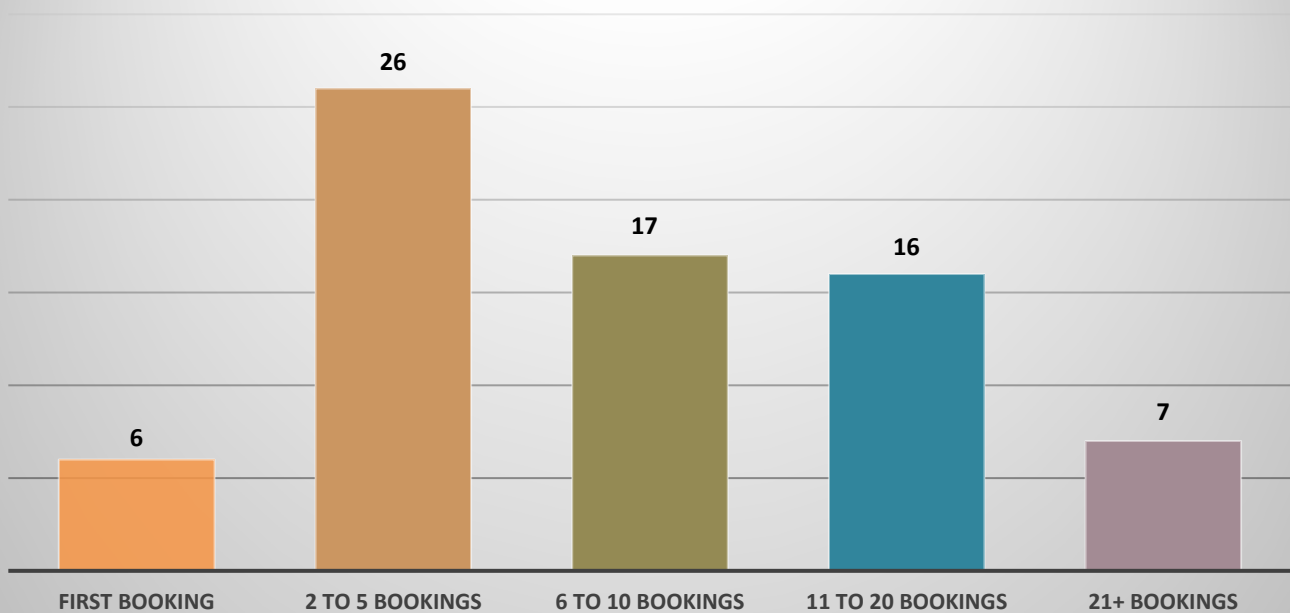
