
Project Benefits

- Long planned and eagerly anticipated by the Roseland community
- Cleaned-up Brownfield sites
- Active and vibrant site now, awaits further improvement
- At least \$125M in planned investment (affordable housing and infrastructure)
- > 175 units of new housing w/75 affordable units
- Significant new community spaces & economic development for Roseland



Funding gap for backbone infrastructure has exceeded \$18 million, paralyzing the project.

Minding the Gap



• June 2023

- Sonoma County budget hearings, Board of Supervisors approved \$7.68 million in one-time funding so that construction of the backbone infrastructure could begin.
- Chair Coursey committed an additional \$2 million from Third District infrastructure funds.
- Senator Mike McGuire and Assemblymember Damon Connelly secured a combined \$3 million in 2023-24 State Budget.
- August 2023
 - \$2 million Ag+Open Space Matching Grant awarded.
- Today's estimated gap stands at \$3,009,680 with committed sources, and at (\$2,810,320) with committed and proposed sources.
