meet their families' holistic needs to foster their children's optimal development, health, and school readiness; and

Whereas, through investing in advocacy to expand access to childcare, affordable housing, health care and a just economy, First 5 Sonoma works to shift public policy, improve community conditions and increase resources that are essential to support optimal child development; and

Whereas, through building the capacity of providers countywide to provide parent education, First 5 Sonoma ensures that families can enhance their knowledge of child development and positive parenting practices that promote strong families; and

Whereas, through centering the values of diversity, inclusion, equity, belonging and anti-racism, First 5 Sonoma County engages the community, builds authentic partnerships and ensures that the voices of those at the margins are elevated.
