NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, Contractor and Commission agree as follows:

### ARTICLE 1 - SCOPE OF WORK OF THE CONTRACT

## 1.1 Work of the Contract:

A. Contractor shall complete all Work specified in the Contract Documents, in accordance with the Specifications, Drawings, and all other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents (Work).

# ARTICLE 2 - COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION OF WORK

## 1.3 Commencement of Work:

- A. Contractor shall commence Work on the date established in the Notice to Proceed (Commencement Date).
- B. Commission reserves the right to modify or alter the Commencement Date after the issuance of Section 00 55 00 (Notice to Proceed).

# 1.4 Completion of Work:

A. Contractor shall achieve Substantial Completion of the entire Work within 691 Days from the Commencement Date.

B. Contractor shall achieve Final Completion of the entire Work 706 Days from the Commencement Date.

# ARTICLE 3 - PROJECT REPRESENTATIVES

## 1.5 Commission's Project Manager:

- A. Commission has designated Ray Tovar, as its Project Manager to act as Commission's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents.
- B. Commission's Project Manager shall have final authority over all matters pertaining to the Contract Documents and shall have sole authority to modify the Contract Documents on behalf of Commission, to accept work, and to make decisions or actions binding on Commission and shall have sole signature authority on behalf of Commission.
- C. Commission's Project Manager and each Commission's Representative are the beneficiary of all Contractor obligations to Commission, including without limitation, all releases and indemnities.

## 1.6 Contractor's Project Manager:

A. Contractor has designated Tony Mencarini as its Project Manager to act as Contractor's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents.

## 1.7 Consulting Engineer:

A. William J. Boriolo-BKF ("Consulting Engineer") furnished the Drawings and Specifications and shall have the rights assigned to Consulting Engineer in the Contract Documents. Consulting Engineer has no authority to act on behalf of Commission, to stop Work, to interpret conditions of the Contract, or to give direction to Contractor.

## ARTICLE 4 - LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY IN COMPLETION OF WORK

## 1.8 Liquidated Damage Amounts:

- A. As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay Commission One thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for each Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Substantial Completion of the entire Work, until achieved.
- B. As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay One thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) for each Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Final Completion of the entire Work, until achieved.

## 1.9 Scope of Liquidated Damages:

- A. Measures of liquidated damages listed in Paragraphs 4.1A and 4.1B above shall apply cumulatively.
- B. Limitations and stipulations regarding liquidated damages are set forth in Section 00 72 00 (General Conditions).

### **ARTICLE 6 - MISCELLANEOUS**

- 1.12 Terms and abbreviations used in this Agreement are defined in Section 00 72 00 (General Conditions) and Section 01 42 00 (References) and will have the meaning indicated therein.
- 1.13 It is understood and agreed that in no instance are the persons signing this Agreement for or on behalf of Commission or acting as an employee, agent, or representative of Commission, liable on this Agreement or any of the Contract Documents, or upon any warranty of authority, or otherwise, and it is further understood and agreed that liability of Commission is limited and confined to such liability as authorized or imposed by the Contract Documents or applicable law.
- 1.14 In entering into a public works contract or a subcontract to supply goods, services, or materials pursuant to a public works contract, Contractor or Subcontractor offers and agrees to assign to the awarding body all rights, title, and interest in and to all causes of action it may have under section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. §15) or under the Cartwright Act (Chapter 2 (commencing with §16700) of Part 2 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code), arising from purchases of goods, services, or materials pursuant to the public works contract or the subcontract. This assignment shall be made and become effective at the time Commission tenders final payment to Contractor, without further acknowledgment by the parties.

- 1.16 Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, are deemed included in the Contract Documents and on file at Commission's Office and shall be made available to any interested party on request. Pursuant to California Labor Code sections 1860 and 1861, in accordance with the provisions of section 3700 of the Labor Code, every contractor will be required to secure the payment of compensation to his employees. Contractor represents that it is aware of the provisions of section 3700 of the Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workers' compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that Code, and Contractor shall comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the Work of the Contract Documents.
- 1.17 This Agreement and the Contract Documents shall be deemed to have been entered into in the County of Sonoma, State of California, and governed in all respects by California law (excluding choice of law rules). The exclusive venue for all disputes or litigation hereunder shall be in the Superior Court for the County of Sonoma.
- 1.18 Contractor shall use either physical or digital signature(s) to execute documents required to be executed by the Contract Documents. Digital signature(s) shall comply with California Government Code section 16.5. By using digital signature(s), Contractor warrants and represents that it intends the digital signature to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature. Electronic signature(s) are not allowed.
