

ORDINANCE NO. ()

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING NEW FEES AND ADJUSTING FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026 FOR THE SONOMA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES PUBLIC HEALTH LAB

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section I. Government Code Section 54985-86, Health and Safety Code Section 101325, and Sonoma County Code Chapter 5 authorize the establishment of new and amended fees to recover the estimated reasonable cost of providing services for the Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory.

Section II. To recover the reasonable cost of providing services for the Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory, it is necessary to adjust those fees set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth in full, commencing July 1, 2026.

Section III. Based on information presented to the Board, the Board finds that the proposed fees comply with all legal requirements, including Art. XIII C, Section 1(e)(1)-(6) of the California Constitution.

Section IV. In all other respects, Ordinance No. 6528 and any fee modifications established by previous resolutions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section V. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and every section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section VI. This ordinance shall be and the same is hereby declared to be in full force and effect from and after thirty (30) days after the date of its passage or July 1, 2026, whichever is greater, and shall be published once before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after said passage, with the names of the Supervisors voting for or against the same, in The Press Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sonoma, State of California.
