Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, to accept California Governor's Office of Emergency Services Victims of Crime Act funding in the amount of \$200,000.

Whereas, the Sonoma County Human Services Department, Family, Youth, & Children's Services Division was awarded funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services on January 5, 2024, to provide essential services at the Redwood Children's Center;

Whereas, the Redwood Children's Center is an accredited Child Advocacy Center that serves as the coordination hub for investigation and intervention services for child victims of sexual and physical abuse; and

Whereas, the Victims of Crime Act grant will fund ongoing therapeutic services for victims and their families; will provide advocacy, support and resources for child victims of sexual assault; and will provide continuing professional development for multidisciplinary staff;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of the Human Services Department to accept funding in the amount of \$200,000 from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, and to execute on behalf of the County of Sonoma the attached Grant Subaward including any extensions or amendments thereof.
