# Cannabis Program Update - Purpose

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- Comprehensive review of existing program
- Ordinance update
- Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)
- Streamlined permitting

# Cannabis Program Update - Background

- June 8, 2021: BOS directed comprehensive program update
- August-Sept 2021: Community engagement
- September 28, 2021: BOS study session
  - ▣ Received report summarizing results of community engagement
  - ▣ Identified overall goals and policy options
- Nov 16, 2021: BOS approved Ord staff

# Cannabis Program Update Framework

- Ensure consistency with BOS direction
- Provide transparency to public on what will be considered during development of the draft ordinance
- Function as preliminary scope of work to inform EIR consultant competitive proposals

# 3. Community Engagement

- Continue to accept written comment
  - ▣ Post on website monthly
- Meetings with interest groups (Zoom)
  - ▣ Meetings to be recorded and posted
- Not proposing to form a new community advisory group
  - ▣ Previous CAG reports and recommendations will be reconsidered

# 4. Allowed Activities

- Evaluate all activities allowed by State
  - ▣ Does not mean will be allowed in ordinance
- Which activities suitable in what GP/Zoning
  - ▣ Activities which are allowed by right
  - ▣ Activities which are allowed by right, but require a business license
  - ▣ Activities which are allowed by ministerial permit
  - ▣ Activities which are allowed by discretionary permit
  - ▣ Activities which are excluded

## 5. General Plan Amendment

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- Ordinance needs to be consistent with GP
- If ag lands suitable for expanded cannabis uses, uses would need to be consistent with GP to preserve and promote agriculture
- Consider GP amendment to ensure compatibility of cannabis with agriculture and agricultural uses
- Ordinance can still impose limitations

# 7. Neighborhood Analysis

- To be informed by data/results of EIR
- Separation criteria – cannabis & residential
  - ▣ Odor, groundwater, visual, safety, and noise
- “Rural Neighborhood enclave”
  - ▣ Residential density and community character
- Criteria for Exclusion Zones
  - ▣ Groundwater, topography, infrastructure, safety, and biological habitat protection

## 8. Permit Streamlining

- To be informed by data/results of EIR
- Site development and operating standards for ministerial permits
- Criteria for Inclusion Zones
  - ▣ Groundwater, infrastructure, safety, biological habitat protection, and proximity/density of sensitive uses
- CEQA streamlining checklist for permits

# 10. Environmental Analysis

- Aesthetics: fences, lights, equipment, hoop houses
- Agriculture: cannabis compatibility with traditional ag
- Air Quality: cannabis odors
- Biological Resources: locally-important watersheds
- Energy: grow lights & HVAC
- Hydrology: overdraft, well interference, streamflow
- Noise: generators, HVAC, vehicles, tourism/events
- Utilities/Services: hoop house & cultivation waste
- Wildfire: road access, response times, water
- Cumulative Impacts: over-concentration

# 12. Equity

- Ordinance development will consider socio-economic equity throughout all policy decisions consistent with Strategic Plan Racial Equity and Social Justice Pillar - Goal 3

*Ensure racial equity throughout all County policy decisions and service delivery*

# 16. Economic Analysis

- Recommended to inform policy decisions such as feasibility of mitigation measures or project alternatives
- Cannabis tax collection revenue & methods
- Staffing costs to implement program
  - ▣ Permitting, compliance inspection, enforcement
- Applicant costs for permits & inspections

  - ▣ March 15, 2022
    - Adopt Resolution of Intention and Program Update Framework
- Draft Ordinance Refinement
  - ▣ March – August 2022
    - March 2022 Initiate competitive RFP process for EIR consultant
    - Resume public engagement
    - August 2022 Preliminary draft ordinance & General Plan Amendment(s) complete for EIR analysis
- Environmental Impact Report
  - ▣ Sept 2022 – Fall 2023
    - Sept 2022 EIR contract award
    - Sept 2022 NOP published
    - Oct 2022 EIR public scoping
    - Fall 2023 Draft EIR published
- Ordinance & EIR Approval
  - ▣ Fall 2023 – Summer 2024
    - Fall 2023 Draft EIR to Planning Commission for public comment
    - Spring 2024 PC hearing
    - Summer 2024 BOS hearing
