**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Whereas, the District Attorney's Office desires to support victims of crime perpetrated by those that are released as a result of California Public Safety Realignment Act (Assembly Bill 109), and to ensure the delivery of appropriate resources and support that are mandated by Marsy's Law (Victim's Bill of Rights as described in the California Constitution); and

Whereas, to implement this work the District Attorney's Office desires to add one full-time, Victim Witness Advocate I/II with an end date of June 30, 2022 and

Whereas, the Victim Witness Advocate I/II supports victims of crime by providing information, support, and referral and advocacy services, in addition to offering assistance in completing victim compensation claims, and navigating the criminal court system.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Department Allocation List of the Sonoma County District Attorney's Office is hereby revised to reflect the addition of one full-time, Victim Witness Advocate I/II.
