**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
Authorizing a budgetary adjustment to the FY 2025–2026 adopted budget for the Public
Defender’s Office (PDO) in the amount of \$304,175 reflecting new funding from the
Department of Health Services via MOU.**

Whereas, the Department of Health Services has received a grant from the California Department of State Hospitals to support local Mental Health Diversion for felony defendants found Incompetent to Stand Trial; and

Whereas, the Department of Health Services designated funding for the Public Defender’s Office in the amount of \$304,175 for Fiscal Year 2025–2026; and

Whereas, the Public Defender’s Office will be allocated \$304,175 to cover costs associated with representing felony defendants found Incompetent to Stand Trial; and

Whereas, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors has adopted the Fiscal Year 2025–2026 final budget for the Public Defender’s Office; and

Whereas, Sections 29088 and 29125 of the Government Code of the State of California allows for adjustments to the final budget during the 2025-2026 fiscal year.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector and the County Executive are hereby authorized and directed to compete the budgetary and accounting transfers and adjustments to the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 budget as follows:
