Proposal includes compaction grouting, pipe pile installation, and re-paving.

The Assistant Director of Permit Sonoma issued an Emergency Coastal Permit on 9 July 2025, to allow the applicant to begin immediate repair of damaged infrastructure for California State Highway 1 which occurred as a result of storm damage. The applicant is required to submit a regular Coastal Permit application for review by the County within 60 calendar days. A Notice of Pending Action issued before the County takes action on the regular Coastal Permit. The approval will be included as an Administrative Determination, as Acts and Determinations on the July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, Agenda of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, specifically, under the *'Permit and Resource Management Department: Review and Possible Action on the Following'* section.
