Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, authorizing the Sonoma County Sheriff-Coroner to Execute the Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, Surrendered and Abandoned Vessel Exchange (SAVE) Grant Agreement, and related documents, in the amount of \$43,000 through September 30, 2022.

Whereas, the Sheriff's Office Marine Unit has identified abandoned and/or derelict vessels in Sonoma County waterways and has requested funding from the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways to fund the removal and disposal of these vessels; and

Whereas, the Marine Unit has implemented a Vessel Turn-In Program, which allows boat owners to surrender an unwanted recreational vessel for disposal; and

Whereas, the Sheriff-Coroner has applied for and has been awarded funding from the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways for the removal and disposal of abandoned and surrendered recreational vessels.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors that Sonoma County's Sheriff-Coroner, Mark Essick, is authorized to execute the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, Surrendered and Abandoned Vessel Exchange contract documents; and is authorized to request reimbursement up to \$43,000.
