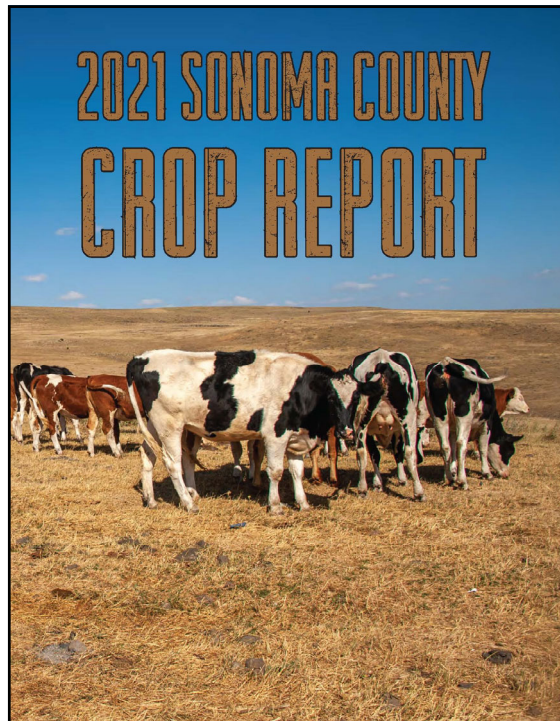

Agriculture in Sonoma County: Adaptive in the Face of Drought

- ▶ Sonoma County saw extreme drought conditions in 2021, with May – November designated as *D4: Extraordinary Drought* by USDA
- ▶ 2021 now considered Sonoma County’s worst drought year on record
- ▶ Dairy and livestock producers, especially organic, faced difficulty with high feed costs and increased competition
- ▶ Grape growers saw average harvest despite reduction in availability and water-conserving measures

2021 Crop Review

- ▶ Total value for 2021 was \$811,446,600, a 19.2% increase from 2020
- ▶ Overall winegrape value increased 51%
 - Value per ton increased to \$2,626 per ton
 - Overall tonnage increased 39.1% from 2020
- ▶ Overall apple value decreased 24%
 - Overall tonnage decreased 23% from 2020
- ▶ Livestock and poultry products decreased by 21%
- ▶ Nursery product value increased 30%

Department Highlights

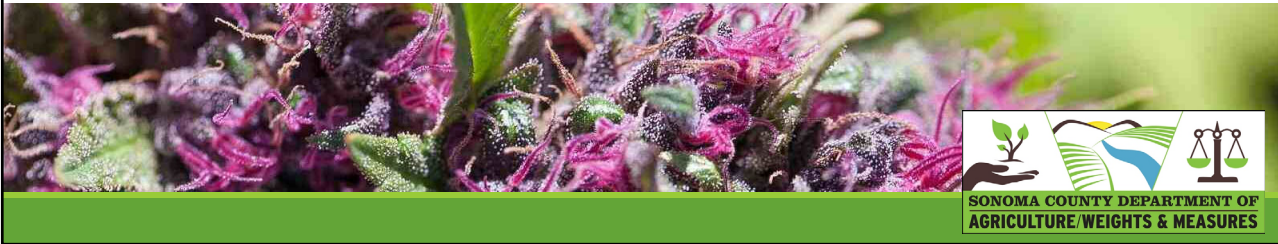
- ▶ Agriculture Division
 - Conducted over 3,400 inspections related to commercial agriculture and pesticide use
 - Placed 5,038 traps for exotic/invasive pests; traps serviced 49,899 times
- ▶ Weights & Measures Division
 - Registered more than 1,900 local businesses and over 34,000 commercial devices
 - Inspected 6,968 weighing and measuring devices and conducted 365 price verifications
- ▶ Land Stewardship Division
 - Reviewed 118 vineyard/orchard development projects on over 2,000 acres

Cannabis and Hemp Production

- ▶ Cannabis Production
 - Overall total value of \$122,752,360 in 2021, including flower, trim, and nursery products
 - 49.73 total acres of Cannabis produced
- ▶ Hemp Production
 - 24.04 total acres of Hemp harvested
