MODIFICATION NUMBER ONE OF AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF SONOMA AND PETALUMA HEALTH CARE DISTRICT

On December 15, 2021, the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter "County") and Petaluma Health Care District (hereinafter "Contractor") entered into a services agreement (hereinafter "Agreement").

Pursuant to Section 13.7 (Merger) of the Agreement, the parties hereby evidence their intent and desire to modify the Agreement as follows:

- 1. Exhibit A (Scope of Work) is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the attached Exhibit A (Scope of Work).
- 2. Exhibit B (Budget) is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the attached Exhibit B (Budget).
- 3. Section 2.2 (Maximum Payment Obligation) is hereby revised to read as follows:

2.2. <u>Maximum Payment Obligation</u>

In no event shall County be obligated to pay Contractor more than the total sum of \$133,971 under the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

4. Article 3 (Term of Agreement) is hereby revised to read as follows:

3. Term of Agreement

The term of this Agreement shall be from August 31, 2021 to December 31, 2022, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 (Termination).

5. Section 13.10 (Counterparts and Electronic Copies) is hereby revised to read as follows:

13.10. Counterparts and Electronic Copies

The parties agree that this Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and together which when executed by the requisite parties shall be deemed to be a complete original agreement. Counterparts may be delivered via facsimile, electronic mail (including PDF), or other transmission method, and any counterpart so delivered shall be deemed to have been duly and validly delivered, be valid and effective for all purposes, and shall have the same legal force and effect as an original document. This Agreement, and any counterpart, may be electronically signed by each or any of the parties through the use of any commercially available digital and/or electronic signature software or other electronic signature method in compliance with the U.S. federal ESIGN Act of 2000, California's Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (Cal. Civil Code § 1633.1 et seq.), or other applicable law. By its use of any electronic signature below, the signing party agrees to have conducted this transaction and to execute this Agreement by electronic means.

Except as expressly modified herein, all terms and conditions of Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Performance Period	Tasks	
PP1	Hire, train, and deploy 2.0 FTE community health workers (CHWs).	
PP1	Contractor's leadership contributes to community program design, develops internal workflows, and engages local clinical and non-clinical service providers in program launch and implementation.	
PP1	Contractor's program supervisor monitors CHWs' performance and liaisons with providers and community partners to ensure smooth operations and effective deployment of CHWs.	
PP2	Contractor's CHWs complete virtual training.	
PP2	Contractor's CHWs initiate work/intern with the Contractor during training.	
PP2	Contractor's CHWs work with community partners to provide outreach to identified residents/specific populations to mitigate the spread of COVID by increasing vaccinations for those eligible to receive vaccinations, offering appropriate education and linking to needed resources and follow up. Efforts will depend on state and local recommendations.	
PP3	Contractor's CHWs work in collaboration with CHW networks in Sonoma County in order to address Social Determinants of Health-related inequities to support the mission and vision of the health care district.	
PP3	Contractor's CHWs participate in the community of practice.
