**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
approving the pass-through of state funds to Alexander Valley Healthcare for the Alexander
Valley Health and Wellness Center**

Whereas, the California Legislature appropriated \$3,500,000 to the County of Sonoma in the 2025 Budget Act to fund the construction of the Alexander Valley Healthcare's Alexander Valley Health and Wellness Center; and

Whereas, Alexander Valley Healthcare provides primary medical, dental, and behavioral health care in Cloverdale; and

Whereas, Alexander Valley Healthcare has been a strong partner of the County of Sonoma in serving vulnerable populations; and

Whereas, Alexander Valley Healthcare is constructing a new facility in southwestern Cloverdale which will allow for expanded medical, dental, and educational services to up to 8,000 patients annually; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors has adopted a Fiscal Year 2025-26 Final Budget for the County of Sonoma; and

Whereas, the Government Code allows for adjustments to the Final Budget during the 2025-26 Fiscal Year.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the County of Sonoma hereby:

1. Accept the \$3,500,000.00 appropriated to the County of Sonoma by the California Legislature via the Department of Social Services in Senate Bill 105 (Chaptered 2025)
2. Directs the County Executive's Office to allocate the \$3,500,000 to Alexander Valley Healthcare for costs associated with the construction of Alexander Valley Health and Wellness Center
3. The County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to make all necessary operating transfers, accounting entries, and the following budgetary adjustments:
