Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Recognizing September 16, 2025, As National Voter Registration Day

Whereas, California's Secretary of State, the State's chief elections official, is committed to strengthening democracy by encouraging voter registration and increasing participation in all elections; and

Whereas, the County of Sonoma actively supports this objective; and

Whereas, civic-minded people and organizations have come together to establish a Tuesday in each September as National Voter Registration Day, with the goal of creating awareness of voter registration opportunities; and

Whereas, the State of California and Sonoma County have made excellent progress in removing obstacles to registration by implementing online voter registration (2012), preregistration for 16 and 17 year-olds (2014, 2009), conditional voter registration (a.k.a. "same-day registration") (2017), and automatic voter registration at the Department of Motor Vehicles (2018); and

Whereas, despite these efforts, tens of thousands of Sonoma County residents are thought to remain unregistered and/or unaware that they need to reregister when they change their name, residence address, or political party affiliation; and

Whereas, the strength of our democracy depends on the willingness of its citizens to participate by choosing the people who will lead them and by voicing their opinions on matters
