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**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,  
authorizing to accept donations of materials, labor, art, services, and funding in connection  
with public construction projects**

**Whereas**, from time to time the Department of Public Infrastructure undertakes public construction projects in which the public may wish to help through in the form of money, goods, or services.

**Whereas**, Government Code section 25355 authorizes delegation to a county officer or employee of authority to accept gifts and bequest;

**Whereas**, Resolution 03-1106 delegates authority to the Director of General Services (now Public Infrastructure) to accept or reject any gift or bequest whether of money, goods or services, when offered in connection with a construction project (including maintenance and repair) limited to \$10,000.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma:

1. That the Director of Sonoma County Public Infrastructure is authorized to accept or reject any gift or bequest, whether of money, goods, or services, when offered in connection with a construction (including maintenance and repair) proved that:
  - a. The Director reasonably determines that the value of the gift or bequest does not exceed \$50,000 per project and

- b. That the case of a gift or bequest of goods, including construction materials as materials are of the type of quality suitable for the project and
  - c. That such goods can be delivered, and used or incorporated into the project without undue additional cost to the County, including the costs associated with delay, and
  - d. That in the case of a gift of services, the services will be of a type and quality suitable for the project, including any qualifications, licensure, or certification required by state or applicable local law, and
  - e. That any such acceptance is in writing
2. That the Director of Public Infrastructure shall periodically report such donations to the Board of Supervisors, and
  3. That any monetary gifts shall be accounted for as unanticipated revenue and appropriated by the Board before they are spent.

**Be It Further Resolved** upon request of the Director of Public Infrastructure and advice of the County Counsel, County officers and employees are authorized and directed to take actions and execute such documents necessary to acknowledge or accept the gift.
