**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,  
Authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Infrastructure (a) to Submit a  
Transportation Art Proposal to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for Art  
on Utility Boxes along the State Route 12 Corridor in the Sonoma Springs Community, (b) to  
Execute a Local Agency Agreement, Transportation Art Maintenance Agreement, and Other  
Agreements, Applications and Permits Required by Caltrans, and (c) to Take all Other Actions  
Necessary to Complete the Project**

**Whereas**, the Springs Municipal Advisory Committee has submitted a proposal to design art and paint utility boxes in the Springs neighborhood along the State Route 12 corridor;

**Whereas**, there has been significant community involvement in the design of the art to reflect the beauty, nature and history of the community;

**Whereas**, the art was created by local non-profit Art Escape;

**Whereas**, art installations within State Right-of-Way require a Transportation Art Proposal submitted to Caltrans;

**Whereas**, the Transportation Art Proposal requires a local agency sponsor.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Board authorizes the Director of the Department of Public Infrastructure to submit a proposal for the “Springs Municipal Advisory Council Utility Box Project” art installation to the Caltrans Transportation Art Program.

**And, Be It Further Resolved** that the Board authorizes the Director of the Department of Public Infrastructure to execute a Local Agency Agreement, Transportation Art Maintenance Agreement, and other agreements, applications and permits required by Caltrans, and take all other actions necessary to complete the project.
