SECOND AMENDMENT

TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE WILDANDS CONSERVANCY AND

SONOMA COUNTY AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION AND OPEN SPACE DISTRICT

This Second Amendment to the Initial Public Access Funding Agreement for the Estero Americano Coast Preserve ("Second Amendment"), effective upon execution by the District General Manager ("Effective Date"), is by and between the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District, a California special district (hereinafter "District"), and The Wildlands Conservancy (hereinafter "TWC").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, District and TWC are parties to that certain Agreement for Initial Public Access Funding for the Estero Americano Coast Preserve, dated February 9, 2021, as amended by that First Amendment dated March 4, 2024 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, District and TWC desire to extend the funding deadline to June 30, 2027 and increase the contract value by Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$287,100.00) in order to address additional permit requirements from the California Coastal Commission and delayed timeline due to legal actions, the Covid-19 pandemic, and neighbor concerns;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

<u>AGREEMENT</u>

- 1. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with the following language:
 - "2. District Funding: Subject to all terms and conditions herein, the District shall provide up to Five Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$586,600) to be used by TWC exclusively for the following tasks ("Tasks") directly related to initial public access to and about the Property:
 - Trail design resource surveys
 - Coastal Permit application preparation, fees, tracking, public hearings

- Public access amenities (including gates, fencing, signs, kiosks, portable restroom rental, and picnic tables)
- Road/trail repairs, upgrades, and erosion control
- Project management and implementation
- Visitor safety and patrols (operations)
- Trail maintenance
- Demolition and habitat restoration
- Tribal consultation and monitoring
- Community engagement and public outings
- a. The funding amounts per category of Task will be identified in a Work Plan to be approved by the District pursuant to Section 3(a) below ("approved Work Plan").
- b. All Tasks shall be undertaken in a manner consistent with the Conservation Easement and the Recreation Covenant. All Tasks shall be in accordance with the approved Work Plan.
- c. District's funding under this Agreement shall be available through June 30, 2027."
- Except to the extent the Agreement is specifically amended or supplemented hereby, the
 Agreement, together with exhibits is, and shall continue to be, in full force and effect as
 originally executed, and nothing contained herein shall, or shall be construed to modify,
 invalidate, or otherwise affect any provision of the Agreement or any right of District arising
 thereunder.
- 3. This Second Amendment shall be governed by and construed under the internal laws of the State of California, and any action to enforce the terms of this Second Amendment or for the breach thereof shall be brought and tried in the County of Sonoma.

DISTRICT AND CONSULTANT HAVE CAREFULLY REVIEWED THIS SECOND AMENDMENT AND EACH TERM AND PROVISION CONTAINED HEREIN AND, BY EXECUTION OF THIS SECOND AMENDMENT, SHOW THEIR INFORMED AND VOLUNTARY CONSENT THERETO.
