Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Approving The Acquisition Of The 100-Acre Ranch Property Subject to Deed Restrictions By

The County of Sonoma; Authorizing The Chair To Execute A Certificate Of Acceptance;

Authorizing The Regional Parks Director To File A Notice Of Exemption With The Sonoma

County Clerk Pursuant To The California Environmental Quality Act And Authorizing All Other

Actions Necessary To Complete The Transaction.

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors desires to acquire approximately 101 acres of undeveloped land adjacent to Hood Mountain Regional Park & Preserve, which land is located at 1616 Los Alamos Road, Santa Rosa; is identified as Assessor's Tax Parcel 028-170-016 ("Property"); and is owned by John M. Rasmason, Trustee of the John M. Rasmason 2006 Trust dated January 6, 2006 and Barbara L. Mix and Alfred C. Mix, Trustees of the Barbara L. Mix and Alfred C. Mix Revocable Living trust dated February 17, 2009 ("Seller"); and

Whereas, Sonoma County Regional Parks has negotiated with the Seller of the Property the purchase thereof by the County of Sonoma at a price of Five Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$555,000), which price is supported by an independent appraisal; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors hereby finds, determines and declares and orders as follows:

- 1. *Truth of Recitals.* The foregoing recitations are true and correct.
- 2. Appropriateness of Acquiring the Property. It is appropriate for the County to acquire
