Family Resource Center Network of Sonoma County (led by La Luz Center; includes Corazon Healdsburg, Child Parent Institute, Petaluma Family Resource Center, Community Action Partnership, Sonoma Immigrant Services, VIDAS Legal Services)	\$160,000	Provide immigrant legal education, Know Your Rights workshops, family preparedness planning, and wraparound services through a countywide network of family resource centers.
Immigrant Health Legal Collaborative (IHLC) (La Familia Sana, Latino Service Providers, Northern California Center for Well-Being, Sonoma CAN)	\$145,000	Deliver community-centered outreach and training integrating health access education, promotoras engagement, and legal rights information for immigrant residents.
African Advocacy Network (AAN)	\$50,000	Expand culturally and linguistically competent immigration legal services for African and Afro-Caribbean immigrant communities in Sonoma County.
KBBF – Bilingual Broadcasting Foundation	\$25,000	Produce multilingual radio programming and community outreach to share information on immigration law, policy updates, and available resources.
Bienestar Collective (fiscal sponsor for Dinastía de Promotoras del Río Ruso)	\$25,000	Conduct Know Your Rights training, family preparedness planning, and health navigation for immigrants in West County through community health workers.
Asian American Pacific Islander Coalition of the North Bay (AAPIC)	\$20,000	Provide Know Your Rights education, legal service referrals, and outreach for AAPI immigrant communities in Sonoma County.
