**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, And The Board Of Directors Of The Sonoma County Water Agency, State of California, Authorizing Adjustments For Various Fees Supporting Camping, Group Reservations, Special Events and Activities, Park Operations, Community Engagement Programs, and Residence Maintenance Fees And New Fees For Field Trip Classroom Pre-Visits; Park Program Fee Discounts For Community Partners, Daily Camp Fees, Cancellation Fees For Camps And Paddleboard and Kayak Rentals and Removing Obsolete Fees For Non-Peak Camping Fees, Group Campsite Reservation And Change Fees, Various Individual Camp Fees, Various Resident/Non-Resident Field Trip Fees And Fee Tiers For The Inflatable Water Park and Modifying Other Fees Requiring Description Changes Without Fiscal Impact Including Second Vehicle For Group And Individual Camping and Description Change For Camps.**

**Whereas**, The County of Sonoma owns and operates sixty Regional Parks, trails and other facilities; and

**Whereas**, it is in the best interest of the County of Sonoma and the general public to maintain and operate said facilities and at a standard of care that provides for the welfare, safety and enjoyment of park visitors;

**Whereas**, adjustments to various fees supporting camping, group use reservations, special events and activities, park operations including day use and seasonal parking, community engagement programs, and residence maintenance fees will increase revenue so the General Funds does not have to be used to pay for these services provided to the fee payors; and

**Whereas,** Regional Parks has reviewed obsolete fees no longer in use for the public; and

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that to recover the reasonable cost of providing certain parks services, it is necessary to increase certain fees and establish certain new fees as set forth below:
