**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Authorizing a Budgetary Adjustment to the Revised 2023-2024 Budget for the County Administrator's Climate Action and Resiliency Budget per the Climate Smart Commodities Grant Received from the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service.**

**Whereas**, the Board of Supervisors has adopted a Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Final Budget for the County of Sonoma County Administrator's Office; and

**Whereas**, the Government Code allows for adjustments to the Final Budget during the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year; and

**Whereas**, the County of Sonoma has received a Climate Smart Commodities Grant from the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service to assist with the goal of maximizing opportunities for mitigation of climate change and adaptation through improved land use and agricultural practices, and increased carbon sequestration. Staff recommends, in accordance with the grant guidelines, adding administrative support staff;
