WHEREAS, UCSF wishes to continue to provide Services, and County wishes to continue to receive such Services under the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, UCSF and County hereby agree to amend the Agreement, as follows:

- 1. The effective date of this First Amendment is July 31, 2025.
- 2. The term of the Agreement is extended through July 30, 2028.
- 3. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and unaffected by this First Amendment and shall continue in full force and effect.
