Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Approving the Conflict of Interest Code for the Geyserville Unified School District

Whereas, the Political Reform Act, Government Code section 81000 et seq. requires state and local government agencies to adopt conflict of interest codes; and

Whereas, state law requires that every two years agencies review their conflict of interest codes and make such changes as are necessary to keep the codes current; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors is the code reviewing body for agencies within the geographic jurisdiction of the County, and charged with the responsibility of ensuring that the amended codes comply with law; and

Whereas, the Geyserville Unified School District has proposed an amendment to update its code to comply with state law; and

Whereas, County Counsel has reviewed the amended code and determined that it complies with the Political Reform Act; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the conflict of interest code of the Geyserville Unified School District is approved as amended. The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this resolution to the Geyserville Unified School District and County Counsel.

RESOLUTION OF THE GEYSERVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code sections 81000 et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt conflict of interest codes, and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code and which can be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments to the Political Reform Act, and

WHEREAS, the wishes to adopt this standard code and designate which officers and employees should disclose financial interests and describe which interests must be disclosed, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendix A and Appendix B, in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the GEYSERVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES, and

2. Pursuant to Section 4 of the standard code, board members shall file statements of economic interest with the Geyserville Unified School District clerk, who shall retain a copy and forward the original for filing with the Clerk of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. Designated employees shall file statements with the Geyserville Unified School District clerk who shall retain them at the main place of business of the Geyserville Unified School District. Any Geyserville Unified School District board member or other designated employee already required to submit a disclosure statement (Form 700) pursuant to Government Code section 87203 may submit a copy of that statement in lieu of any filing required by this code provided that no additional disclosure would be required by this code.

Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the Code subject to the following limitation:

The Superintendent may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position" is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and) based upon that description, a statement of the extent of the disclosure requirements. The Superintendent's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code,

APPENDIX B

GEYSERVILLE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Disclosure Categories¹

Category 1

Designated employees assigned to this category must report:

Interests in real property which are located in whole or in part: (1) within the boundaries of the Geyserville Unified School District (2) within five miles of the boundaries of the Geyserville Unified School District, or (3) within two miles of any land owned or used by the Geyserville Unified School District, including any leasehold beneficial or ownership interest or option to acquire such interest in real property.

Category 2

Investments and business positions in business entities or income from sources which are contractors or subcontractors engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the Geyserville Unified School District.

Category 3

Designated employees assigned to this category must report investments and business positions in business entities and. income from sources which manufacture¥ sell or provide, supplies, materials, books, machinery, services or equipment of the type utilized by the employee's department or the

¹Only investments in and sources of income from business entities, and sources of income, which do business in the geographic area of the Geyserville Unified School District, or real property interests located in the District, need to be reported.

Geyserville Unified School District. For purposes of this category a principal's department is his/her entire school.
