



Sanitation Rate Relief Program

Why?

People with reduced or fixed income may struggle to pay sanitation bills

Who?

- Residential customers who own and live in their home as their primary residence
- Current participant in the PG&E CARE Program, or
- Total income of all persons living in the home of 60% or less of the area median family income
- 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations that provide housing to low-income renters

How much?

- 50% of FY 24-25 sewer bill for eligible customers
- Up to \$600,000 from Sonoma Water General Fund

How will people be informed?

 Website, social media, press release, outreach through social service agencies and non-profit organizations
