Redistricting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

- Equal Population
- Federal Voting Rights Act
- No Racial Gerrymandering

2. California Criteria for Counties

To the extent practicable:

1. Geographically contiguous
2. Undivided neighborhoods and “communities of interest”
(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
3. Cities and Census-designated places
4. Easily identifiable boundaries
5. Compactness
(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

Prohibited:

“Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party.”

3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

- Minimize voters shifted to different election years
- Respect voters’ choices / continuity in office
- Future population growth
- Preserving the core of existing districts

California criteria - order of priority

1. To the extent practicable, geographically contiguous.
2. To the extent practicable, minimize division of community of interest. Consider whether should be included within a single supervisorial district for purposes of its effective and fair representation. **Communities of interest do not include relationships with political parties, incumbents, or political candidates.**
3. To the extent practicable, minimizes division of a city.
4. To the extent practicable, bounded by natural and artificial barriers, by streets or by the boundaries of the county.
5. To the extent practicable, **where it does not conflict with the preceding criteria above**, drawn to encourage compactness

- Supervisor and public input received since the Advisory Redistricting Commission (ARC) concluded their work through November 4th was considered in the additional draft maps
- Key themes from public input 10/22-11/4/21
 - Unify Rohnert Park into District 3
 - Keep current district map
- The maps are still draft although the goal of today's meeting is to identify a preferred map

- Minimal change to boundaries is desirable
- The coast should remain unified within one district
- Rohnert Park should be unified within one district. It is preferable but not necessary for Rohnert Park and Cotati to be aligned within the same district.
- The Springs area (Eldridge-Fetters hot Springs Agua Caliente-Boyes Hot Springs) to remain unified
- Roseland and Moorland areas to be included in the district representing downtown Santa Rosa (currently D3)
- Coffey Park-Larkfield-Mark West-Wikiup should be unified and in the same district
- Russian River communities (Forestville-Guerneville-Monte Rio) should be unified within the same district
- Ideally seek to improve Sonoma Valley's voice and representation
- Align the area West of Hwy 101 west of Cotati with Petaluma as they share the same identity and legacy history.





- Population balanced with 2020 census data




